Review Policy

Manuscripts submitted to WALLY are reviewed by the journal editors for appropriateness in terms of focus and scope. Papers must meet the language standards of the journal. Editors and peer reviewers may provide both content and writing feedback for revisions as appropriate.

Open Access Policy

WALLY is an open access journal that provides immediate and free access for anybody to read and download its publications. All content published by WALLY is licensed under the <u>Creative Commons Attribution-Non Commercial 4.0 International (CC BY-NC 4.0) license</u>. This licence allows readers to download, copy, redistribute, and adapt articles published by WALLY for non-commercial purposes, provided that proper attribution is given and the conditions of the licence are stated. Authors retain copyright and grant WALLY right of first publication.

Publishing Schedule

WALLY publishes as a rolling, year-long issue. This means that articles are published as they are received, so authors can submit work throughout the year. Annual issues open January 1st and close December 31st. Special issues are published as supplementary issues within the same annual volume.
